The nomination is to translate OTARC’s smartphone app, [ASDetect](#), into 5 major languages so that young children worldwide can benefit from early autism detection. ASDetect has already assessed over 4000 children in Australia, and now they need your help to extend the app, potentially benefitting up to 73 million children with autism worldwide.
